Perform routine maintenance on all District's vehicles & equipment.
Maintain a clean & safe work area at all times.
Train and oversee maintenance work by other employees.
Follow OSHA regulations for safety and operations.
Maintain updated repair and maintenance logs on all District equipment including stormwater pumping facilities.
